The First Steps

The initial research phase of SuCESS “Needs analysis and preparing the soil” (WP1) includes a review of the state of art and teachers training needs in the field of criminology and public safety in South American Universities. The Euro-South-American Interuniversity network

One of the project's main results (under WP3) will be the *Euro-South-American Interuniversity network*, which will gather professionals and students working and studying in the areas of criminology and public security. Furthermore, this network will include an online repository with materials and resources relevant for research and teaching, such as: studies about criminology and public security, educational materials, papers and journals, etc. Under the participation of SuCESS in ERASMUS days 2020, a short video will be launched about this network.

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Next Activities : WEBINARS



SUCCESS is advancing! We are finalizing the first stage related to gathering information on the needs and competences in the consortium. To close this stage, we have programmed a series of Webinars. They will take place throughout November, on 04, 06, 13, 16, 20, 23 and 27. On the first day, the team from the Miguel Hernandez University in Elche (UHM, Spain), who leads WP1, will present to the consortium members the results of the analysis of all the data collected to know the "State of the Art" in terms of Criminology in the countries involved. In the following days, the teams of the European partners will present some contents and their research. It will be a very important moment to the preparation of study plans that will be the focus of WP2!
